The stormwater website is successfully functioning as a public education tool based on the 36,313 recorded "hits" during the current reporting period. This figure represents a 31% increase over the number of site visitors recorded in previous program year (11,258). Usage of the online library held steady at 559 recorded hits, up only 20 hits from the previous program year.

Articles were published on May 17, July 19, and November 15, 2011. Point of sale, home delivery and direct distribution totals of each edition were 27,000. 100 additional copies of the May and July, and 70 copies of the November article were requested for distribution at municipal offices. Develop large format stormwater "posters" that will be displayed in CENTRO bus shelters across the Syracuse metropolitan area. 24 posters will be displayed in bus shelters for a period of one month.

Bus shelter locations were posted in 24 bus shelters that were either located in or served bus routes that ran through 17 MS4 communities. Individual locations were selected to maximize viewership based on consideration of the number of routes served (366), route ridership numbers and estimated road traffic counts (anecdotal provided by NYDMAL Communications), and overall street visibility. The posters ran for a minimum of 55 days each.

Basic information on planning and permit concepts, low impact development and GI approaches to stormwater management, the "new" runoff reduction stormwater design process, and how to conduct a review of the new design process will be presented.

The May 18, 2011 workshop held at the Tennessee Grande Hotel in Syracuse was attended by 48 planning and zoning board members representing 24 MS4 communities.
