The Village of North Syracuse has decided to continue the monthly Bulk Waste Pickup to try to keep the Village a clean looking community and not have unsightly trash at the curb all month long. There are guidelines established for the removal of the Bulk Waste. DPW will not pick up Bulk items from Businesses in the Village.

BULK WASTE: You MUST CALL the DPW at 315-458-0790 by Friday before 3:00pm and leave your name, address, phone number, and what you have to pick up. All items must be out to the road the night before pick up. If you live on a corner, you must also indicate the street where the items will be placed. If you have not called by the Friday before to have your address put on the pickup list, your items will not be picked up. The North Syracuse DPW will pick up bulk as quickly as they can. Please do not put anything in the roadway or under overhead wires.

- There is a (10) item limit per calendar year per tax parcel
- Bulk Pickup is the 1st Monday of March October
- Bulk waste over (10) item yearly limit, or not considered Bulk Waste will be left for the property owner to remove items from the curb as soon as possible. Items not removed after the pickup, will be subject to a fine. NO bulk waste can be brought into the Village. Individuals bringing bulk waste into the Village will be subject to a \$2,500 fine.

Items NOT Acceptable for Bulk Waste pickup:

- NO TV's
- NO paints of any kind & NO liquids of any kind
- Anything that can be put in a trash bag or garbage can
- Small boxes of shoes, books, or clothing
- Small electric appliances such as: toasters, can openers, microwaves, etc.
- Computer or hardware or printers
- NO tires or construction material or asbestos of any kind
- Anything with a refrigerant/freon such as: refrigerators, dehumidifiers, air conditioners, etc.
