Scissor Trusses & Flat Bottomed Gable Ends

Is it acceptable to place a scissor truss adjacent to a flat bottomed gable on an exterior wall?

The answer is NO. The gable truss should be the same scissor profile as the common scissor. See Figure 1 below for an example of this scenario.



Why is this practice discouraged and what does the code say about it?

Chapter 23, Section 2308.5.1 of the IBC 2018 code states the following:

Size, height and spacing. The size, height and spacing of studs shall be in accordance with Table 2308.5.1 except that utility-grade studs shall not be spaced more than 16 inches (406mm) o.c., or support more than a roof and ceiling, or exceed 8 feet (2438 mm) in height for exterior walls and load-bearing walls or 10 feet (3048 mm) for interior non load-bearing walls. Studs shall be continuous from a support at the sole plate to a support at the top plate to resist loads perpendicular to the wall. The support shall be a foundation or floor, ceiling or roof diaphragm or shall be designed in accordance with accepted engineering practice.

Chapter 6, Section R602.3 of the IRC2018 similarly states the following:

Studs shall be continuous from support at the sole plate to a support at the top plate to resist loads perpendicular to the wall. The support shall be a foundation or floor, ceiling or roof diaphragm or shall be designed in accordance with accepted engineering practice.


The key element of these code passages is that the top of the wall must be supported at the roof or ceiling diaphragm. When the end wall is constructed such that the top plate is level with the exterior walls, there is no diaphragm at the intersection of the wall and a flat bottomed gable truss (see photo in Figure 1 above).




Scissor Trusses & Flat Bottomed Gable Ends

Page 50 of the BCSI-B3 states the following:

A Flat Bottom Chord Gable End Frame used with adjacent Trusses that have sloped bottom chords (see figure B3-42B) creates a hinge in the wall/gable interface that is below the Bottom Chord plane diaphragm. This condition is prohibited by some Building codes because adequate Bracing of this condition is difficult and sometimes impossible. Special end wall Bracing design considerations are required by the Building Designer if the Gable End Frame profile does not match the adjacent Trusses.







What is the best way to design a gable end frame to eliminate this bracing issue?

Best practices show that a Building Designer has better design options at their disposale. One method is to design a balloon-framed end wall, which will completely eliminate any need for a gable end frame. Another method is to use a gable end frame, but to make it match the profile of the adjacent scissor trusses so that the bracing can be installed correctly.

See Figures B3-41 and B3-42A below from BCSI-B3 for examples of each of these solutions:







Scissor Trusses & Flat Bottomed Gable Ends

What is the risk of continuing to install scissor trusses next to flat bottomed gable ends?

- 1. Not all Professional Engineers are willing to seal trusses containing this scenario. If a Professional Engineer does put their seal on this, there may be a note calling attention to said scenario on the truss drawing in which it will state that the lateral bracing is the responsibility of the Engineer of Records.
- 2. Due to the lack of proper lateral bracing and the hinge created across the bottom of the flat bottomed gable end, this gable end truss will have very little resistance to any horizontal pressure/lateral loads that might be applied on the wall during inclimate weather. See Figure 2 as an example.



Whereas, the Village maintains a Freshwater Wetland area located generally between Chestnut Street, Tolbert Drive and Woods Roads pursuant to an Order supplied to the Village by the Department of Environmental Conservation in April, 1986, and,

Whereas the Wetland area is undevelopable, and preserved in an unaltered state to aid the natural course of water drainage within the Village pursuant to the Freshwaters Wetland Act (Article 24 of the ECL), and,

Whereas, it may be necessary to perform or allow the performance of routine maintenance along the boundaries of the Wetland area in order to safeguard adjacent landowners on a case by case basis, and,

Whereas, the Village was informed by a professional arborist hired by adjacent resident Gary Rainbow of 214 Tolbert Drive that there may be 3-4 trees located inside the Wetland area that could damage the resident's property if they fell on same and are currently in need of maintenance, remediation and/or felling, IT IS HEREBY,

RESOLVED, Gary Rainbow of 214 Tolbert Drive is hereby granted temporary permission to enter the Wetland area for the purpose of trimming or felling 3-4 trees adjacent to his property, at his sole cost and expense. This permission is temporary in nature, and shall expire six (6) months from the date of this resolution.

A G R E E M E N T

AN AGREEMENT, made the 1st day of January 2023, between the TOWN OF CLAY, Onondaga County, State of New York, acting for and on behalf of the CLAY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT, hereinafter described as the party of the first part, and the VILLAGE OF NORTH SYRACUSE, Onondaga County, State of New York, herein designated as the party of the second part, as follows, viz:

WHEREAS, there has been duly established in the said Town of Clay, a Fire Protection District, known as the Clay Fire Protection District, embracing all of the territory in said Town, outside of existing incorporated Villages and Fire Districts, and

WHEREAS, this Contract has been duly authorized by the Board of Trustees of the Village of North Syracuse, Onondaga County, State of New York, the party of the second part, and

NOW, THEREFORE, the party of the First part, for and on behalf of the Clay Fire Protection District does hereby engage the party of the second part to furnish fire protection in such territory in the said Clay Fire Protection District as herein designated by the party of the first part, and the second party agrees to furnish such protection in the manner following, to wit:

- 1. The fire department of the said party of the second part shall, at all times during the period of this Agreement, be subject to call for attendance upon any fire or emergency occurring in that portion of said Fire Protection District herein designated by the first party, and, when notified by alarm or telephone call from any person within the said territory of a fire or emergency within such territory to be served by the second party, such fire department of the second party shall respond and attend upon the fire or emergency without unnecessary delay with suitable equipment and a sufficient number of volunteer firemen of the second party, and upon arriving at the scene of the fire or emergency, shall proceed with diligence in the extinguishment of such fire or render necessary aid appropriate to the emergency.
- 2. The fire department of the party of the second part shall, at all times during the term of this Contract, participate in the Onondaga County Mutual Aid Program of fire protection.
 - 3. The term of this Agreement is from January 1, 2023 to December 31, 2023.

- 4. In consideration of furnishing aid and the use of its apparatus as aforesaid and renegotiation of this contract, the party of the second part shall receive the sum of \$232,183 on or before March 1, 2023 for January 1, 2023, to December 31, 2023, in addition thereto a sum not to exceed \$65,000 per year shall be paid based upon the total cost of the Length of Service Award Program for the term of this contract. An amount not to exceed \$49,023 shall be paid separately to North Syracuse Volunteer Firefighter's Association.
- 5. Members of the fire department of the party of the second part, while engaged in the performance of their duties in answering, attending upon or returning from any call provided for by this Contract shall have the same rights, privileges, and immunities as if performing the same in the area designated under Paragraph "7" herein.
- 6. All moneys to be paid under any provision of this Agreement shall be charged upon the said Clay Fire Protection District to be assessed and levied upon the taxable property in said District and collected with the Town taxes.
- 7. The territory located in the Clay Fire Protection District and to be protected by the second party under this Agreement is bounded as follows: BEGINNING at the southeast corner of the Town of Clay, said point also being the southeast corner of Farm Lot No. 91 of the said Town of Clay, running thence westerly along the southerly line of the Town of Clay, said southerly line also being the southerly line of Farm Lot Nos. 91 and 90 of said Town to the point of intersection of said southerly line with the westerly line of said Farm Lot No. 90; thence northerly along said westerly line of Farm Lot No. 90 and Farm Lot No. 78 to the point of intersection of said westerly line with a line drawn parallel to the centerline of Buckley Road, said parallel line being located 200 feet southwesterly from the said centerline of Buckley Road measured perpendicularly therefrom; thence northwesterly along said parallel line to a point on said parallel line located 200 feet northwesterly from the intersection of said parallel line with the centerline of Bear Road; thence northeasterly and parallel to the centerline of said Bear Road and 200 feet northwesterly therefrom to a point on said parallel line which is 200 feet northeasterly measured from the point of intersection of said parallel line with the centerline of Buckley Road; thence northerly and parallel to the easterly line of Farm Lot 77 to the point of intersection of said parallel line with the northerly line of Farm Lot No. 77; thence easterly along the northerly line of Farm

Lot Nos. 77, 78 and 79 to the easterly line of the Town of Clay; thence southerly along said easterly line of the Town of Clay to the place of beginning.

This territory description is more modernly depicted on the Boundary Map attached hereto and labeled "Exhibit A."

EXCEPTING therefrom all lands within the Incorporated Village of North Syracuse and all lands of Hancock Field.

- 8. The Town of Clay, at its own expense, may request and conduct a review of the books, assets and expenses of the Firefighter's Association and Village of North Syracuse upon reasonable notice.
- 9. The party of the second part agrees to defend and indemnify the party of the first part against liability for any and all claims, demands, loss payments, suits, actions, recoveries and judgments of every nature and description brought or recovered against it by reason of any omission or act of the party of the second part, its agents, volunteers/employees, any sub-contractors, his or their agents or employees, including also any omission or supervisory act of the party of the first part, its employees or agents in the performance of this Agreement, and shall hold, the party of the first part harmless therefrom.
- 10. The party of the second part shall obtain insurance coverage as hereinafter set forth and shall furnish to the party of the first part Certificates of Insurance that such insurance is in effect for the contract period. In addition thereto the party of the first part shall be named as an additional insured on said policies. The party of the second part shall provide Workers' Compensation and Employers' Liability Insurance, including disability benefits required by law. Comprehensive General Liability, including premises, completed operations; broad form property damage and broad form contractual will be provided. Automobile Liability Insurance will also be provided for each accident because of bodily injury including death at any time resulting therefrom, as well as adequate provision for property damage.

The policy so provided shall include an endorsement that the Town of Clay will be notified by Registered Mail, fifteen (15) business days prior to any changes in or cancellation of any policy.

11. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary herein, the party of the first part shall have the option to terminate this agreement at the end of any calendar year as specified herein, in the event that the Town of Clay creates fire districts, undertakes a consolidation of existing Fire Protection Districts, or undertakes a modification of Fire Protection District boundaries, any of which actions affect the territorial limits of the boundaries of the party of the second part. The party of the first part shall give at least ninety (90) days notice of its intent to exercise such option.
