As required by the New York State General Municipal Law, the Village of North Syracuse hereby notifies you of a pending project that is located within 500' of the municipal border of the Village of North Syracuse, Town of Clay and Town of Cicero.

Please be advised under the Village of North Syracuse Code, the property located at 709 N. Main St. (Tax ID. No. 013.-01-03.1) known as Bear Road Plaza, owned by 709 Bear Road Partners, LLC. which is zoned C-2A (Storage Unit District). As per §240-12.1 B. it refers other uses to follow permitted uses in §240-12 Commercial C-2 District. We have taken in an amended application from Akina Sushi Syracuse, Inc, which have proposed a sit-down Japanese Sushi and Hibachi Restaurant to go in where the former Key Bank was located in Space #9; they will not be using the drive thru, and have asked to appear before the Planning Commission for Site Plan Review and Approval with Special Permit. As per §240-12 B. (4) Restaurant/bar requires an issuance of a Special Permit.

The Village Planning Commission shall conduct a meeting to review the proposals on July 18<sup>th</sup>, 2024 commencing at 5:30 PM and to be held at the North Syracuse Community Center at the corner of South Bay Road and Centerville Place in the Village, unless otherwise specified.
