

OCWA employees will be in the Village of North Syracuse distributing door hangers (see below) as part of their Service Line Material Identification Door Tagging Campaign.

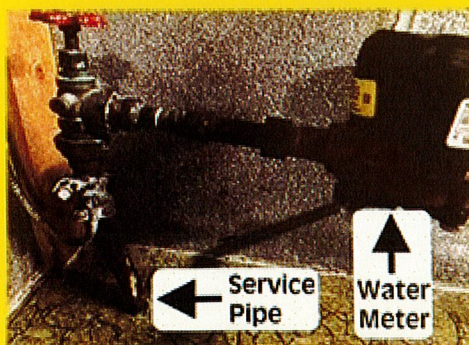
The campaign was launched to comply with new federal regulations requiring all water systems to identify the type of material used to construct every water service connection in its service area. OCWA employees are placing door tags on houses and commercial buildings in targeted areas where service materials need to be identified.

Any OCWA employee placing door tags will have an OCWA ID badge, drive an OCWA vehicle, and wear OCWA gear. OCWA will be contacting those who fail to report their service material using one of the two methods for reporting back to us (see door tag).
