### **2026 BRUSH PICK UP INFORMATION**

We at the Village of North Syracuse would like to thank our Residents in advance of our 2026 Bulk Waste Pickups for their cooperation and patience. We want to keep the Village a clean looking community and not have unsightly trash at the curb. We have established the following guidelines for the removal of the Bulk Waste:

- Call the DPW at 315-458-0790 ANY TIME during the month prior to the pick up to add your address to the pickup list.
- Calls after 3:00pm on the Friday before the scheduled Monday pickup will not be added to the current pick up date. You will have to wait until the next month.
- Mattresses will be picked up for a fee, payable at the Department of Public Works office (Ferguson Ave). Please call to arrange a time for payment (cash or check-made payable to "Village of North Syracuse: only). No credit cards are accepted. Please call for current mattress fee as set by OCRRA.
- When leaving a voicemail, please leave your name, address and phone number where we can return your call.
- If you live on a corner, please indicate which street you will place your items.
- It usually takes a few days to pick up all of the bulk throughout the Village, but we ask that ALL items are at the curb by Sunday night before the pickup date.

- **There is a (10) item limit per calendar year per tax parcel**
- **Bulk Pickup is the 1<sup>st</sup> Monday of April – October, except September-see above date**
- **Bulk waste over (10) item yearly limit, or not considered Bulk Waste will be left for the property owner to remove items from the curb as soon as possible. Items not removed after the pickup, will be subject to a fine. NO bulk waste can be brought into the Village. Individuals bringing bulk waste into the Village will be subject to a \$2,500 fine.**

### **ITEMS NOT ACCEPTABLE FOR BULK WASTE PICKUP:**

- NO TV's
- NO paints of any kind & NO liquids of any kind
- NO trash bags, boxes, full garbage cans
- NO Small boxes of shoes, books, or clothing
- NO Small electric appliances such as: toasters, can openers, microwaves, etc.
- NO Computers, hardware or printers
- NO tires or construction material or asbestos of any kind
- NO items with a refrigerant/freon such as: refrigerators, dehumidifiers, air conditioners, etc.

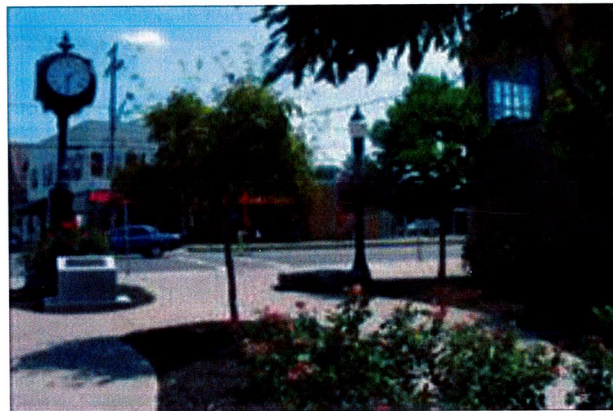

**NO** alcoholic beverages are allowed without a certificate of insurance naming the **Village of North Syracuse** as *additional insured*. A copy of this insurance certificate must be turned in before your rental date.

**Cancellation/Refund Policy:** If cancelling a reservation, a 30 day notice is required in order to receive your refund. Please note there is a \$25 cancellation fee if cancelling a reservation with a 30 day or more notice. If cancelling with less than 30 days notice there will be additional cancellation fees.

The deposit fee is refundable providing all operating procedures have been followed. Please allow up to 4 weeks for deposit refund as Checks are mailed out on the Friday after Village Board Meetings which occur the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Thursday of each month.

**\*\*\*Use fee and deposit must be paid in full 1 week from booking the event and can be paid by cash, check, credit card or money order.**
